



The Stephenville Parks and Recreation Department operate an Administrative Office located at 298 W. Washington and a **Recreation Center located at 378 W. Long Street**. All registration should be completed at the Recreation Center or online at our city web site. Office hours are **Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 5:00pm**. You may contact us at (254) 918-1295. All programs offered by the Stephenville Parks and Recreation Department will emphasize participation and enjoyment. It is our goal that every participant has the same opportunity to participate in an activity and to have fun! Another goal of our department is to not leave anyone out. We want to extend an invitation to everyone to participate. **Our philosophy of recreation is simple – “we must plan for the way people function rather than force them to function within the limits of our plans”.**

SPARD retains the privilege of canceling any scheduled activity that fails to generate minimum interest.

## Facilities

### CITY PARK (378 W. LONG STREET)

The Recreation Hall is located in the front of the City Park. The city park has the following facilities: three baseball fields, three softball fields, four multi-purpose youth fields, four tennis courts, one multi-purpose court, hike and bike trail, Century Park Gazebo, Birdsong Amphitheater, two covered pavilions, swimming pool, eight RV spaces, three playground area, fishing dock and the Bosque River Trail begins in the park.

### OPTIMIST/JAYCEE PARK

The Optimist Park is located at Harbin Drive and Lingleville Highway. This park includes a walking and bike trail, a covered multi-purpose court, and a playground area.

### STEPHENVILLE DOWNTOWN PLAZA

The Stephenville Downtown Plaza is located on Washington Street across from City Hall. This facility features the Cowboy Capital Walk of Fame plaques. Various special events are held at the Downtown Plaza.

## Rental Information

Certain facilities are available to the public for a rental fee. Facilities that may be rented include the Century Park Gazebo, Recreation Hall, Pavilions, Splashville (city swimming pool), Ball fields, Birdsong Amphitheater, RV spaces, and the Downtown Plaza. Rental fees vary with facility. All reservations should be made at the Stephenville Parks and Recreation Department office located 378 W. Long Street or Community Services Dept at 298 West Washington.
