PAVENT RE-SURFACING

“Re-surfacing” of your street will begin

Please expect lane and or total street closures. If for any reason the street is not completed as scheduled, it will be rescheduled for another day and you will be re-notified the day before.

Method: Seal Coat

Chip seals are the most common surface treatment for low-volume roads. A chip seal is an application of asphalt followed by an aggregate cover. The asphalt is usually applied as a hot emulsified asphalt. After the asphalt emulsion is applied to the pavement surface, aggregate is immediately applied over the asphalt before the hot asphalt emulsion cools. A pneumatic roller is used to reorient or seat the aggregate particles and tighten the rock matrix. After the asphalt cures, the excess aggregate is removed by brooming the surface.

DO NOT DRIVE YOUR CAR THROUGH BARRICADES OR OUT OF YOUR DRIVEWAY WAIT UNTIL THE STREET IS OPENED

If you walk or drive on the chip seal surface before it has set you can damage the installation and the product will stick to your feet and/or car. Vehicles observed disobeying traffic control signs and/or barricades will be ticketed and responsible for repairs to the damaged material.

During the day when the chip seal is placed, please note the following:

- 1) This area is one of several scheduled for this day. **Construction will start anytime between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm.** Once started there will be no vehicles allowed in the area until the barricades are removed
- 2) Please move all parked vehicles and debris from the street. Please observe the **“NO PARKING”** signs. Parked vehicles may be towed away.
- 3) Please turn off your sprinklers 24 hours before and after the chip seal placement. Nuisance water will damage and discolor the new surface.

With your cooperation, it will be possible to get this work done quickly and with minimum inconvenience to all concerned. If you need to use your car this day, please park it on a side street that **does not have a “NO PARKING” sign on it prior to 6:30 am.** If you have any concerns, please contact:
