COVID-19
DISASTER DECLARATION
SHELTER IN PLACE

IN PLACE 11:59 PM ON MARCH 25, 2020

All individuals currently living within the City of Stephenville are ordered to shelter at their place of residence, which includes hotels, motels, shared rentals and similar facilities. All persons may leave their residences only for ESSENTIAL ACTIVITIES.

ESSENTIAL ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

- medical (ex: supplies, healthcare, medication)
- necessary services or supplies for themselves or their family or household members or to deliver said services or supplies to others (ex: food, pet supplies, consumer products and necessary products for sanitation, safety and essential operations of residences)
- to engage in outdoor activity, provided activities comply with social distancing requirements of six (6) feet (walking, biking, hiking, running, etc.)
- to perform work or travel to and from jobs, including construction or ag services, provided individuals comply with social distancing requirements of six (6) feet,
- to care for a family member or pet in another household

CHILDCARE REGULATIONS:

- All temperatures must be checked upon entrance and taken throughout the day in 90 minute intervals & children must be sent home if a fever exists,
- 10 or fewer children only in a group
- Each childcare provider must stay with only one group of children and not change throughout the day.

BUSINESS CLOSURES:

- Tanning, Hair, Barber, and Nail salons
- Massage Parlors (and massage parlors ancillary to another business, unless prescribed by healthcare professional)
- Meeting Spaces (residential, hotel or outdoor)
- Tattoo Parlors

BUSINESS REGULATIONS:

- Monitor body temperatures of all employees
- Disinfect businesses prior to opening and throughout the day
- Encourage employee handwashing on an hourly basis
- Limit travel of employees outside the city limits of the City of Stephenville
- Where no automatic doors are present, at least one door must remain permanently open during business hours
- Must provide hand sanitizing station at entrance
- Allow working from home if job function permits

SAFE SHOPPER HOURS:

- Ages 60 and older
- 6:00 am to 10:00 am
- Monday, Thursdays and Saturdays
- Grocery stores, general stores, and dollar type stores
- Excludes: hardware stores, pharmacies, and other soft good stores

OTHER IMPACTS:

- Toilet paper may only be purchased in a 12 pack or one package, whichever is greater.
- The City of Stephenville will not terminate utility services for the duration of this declaration.
- The City of Stephenville will designate funds in the amount of \$250,000 to help restaurants and personal service businesses within the City of Stephenville that have been affected by the COVID-19.
- If someone in a household tests positive for COVID-19, the entire household must isolate themselves
