



ERATH COUNTY VACCINATION CENTER FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When does the Erath County Vaccination Center (ECVC) open?

The ECVC will open Thursday, January 28.

Where will the ECVC be located?

The ECVC will be located at 2900 W. Washington Suite 92, in the building that formerly housed J.C. Penney and FFO Furniture.

How do I contact the ECVC?

The phone number is 254-459-5053

Who will receive the first vaccinations?

Recipients of the vaccine this week will be Erath County residents listed in groups 1A and 1B as published by Texas DSHS, and who have registered with Tarrant County Priority will be given to those registered by date, and group 1A.

How will I know when I can get my vaccine?

Registrants will be contacted by a County official for their appointment date and time.

There will be no walk-ins allowed.

How do I register to be on the list?

Any Erath County resident interested in receiving a vaccine at the ECVC, please go to https://www.tarrantcounty.com/en/public-health/disease-control---prevention/COVID-19/COVID-19-Vaccine.html to register their information.

Will I receive the Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine?

At this time, the ECVC only has the Moderna vaccinations.

If I received my first vaccination somewhere else, do I register at ECVC for my second vaccination?

No, we encourage you to report to your original provider to receive your follow-up vaccination.

Do I have to re-register for my second vaccine?

No, The ECVC will contact you for your appointment for your second vaccination.

How long will the ECVC be open?

Because over 1,300 Erath County residents are currently registered with Tarrant County, this will be an ongoing effort extending long past these doses. Erath County and the City of Stephenville have made arrangements to be able to receive the vaccine and anticipate an increasing supply in the future.

How do I get more information about the ECVC?

As more arrangements are made and vaccine supply increases in availability, more information about how and when to receive the vaccine through the ECVC will be released.
