🛧 Public Works Major Project Updates

Eastside Sewer Project: The city council authorized the funding application from the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB). The application was preliminarily approved and is under technical review by the TWDB. Letters have been sent to property owners requesting permission to survey along the proposed route. Preliminary drawings and specifications have been delivered to staff and are under review. Submittals to meet environmental and right-of-way requirements are due this December.

2016 TSU Methodist Branch Sanitary Sewer Line Relief Project: Water lines are complete and 21" sewer lines are in the process of being installed on Green Street. Paradigm parking lot, 555 W. Washington, work has been complete and repaved. Brick is being relayed on N. Paddock toward Green Street.

Inglewood Paving Project: The resurfacing project began on November 29, with an estimated completion date of December 7, 2016.

2016 CDBG Project—Oak & Elm: The Grant Administration and Professional Services contract was awarded to Public Management, Inc., and engineering services was awarded to Pacheco Koch, LLC.

- Repaired over two dozen utility cuts
- Repaved First Street with the new asphalt paver
- New street signs were installed to replace missing or damaged signs
- New street sign posts were installed to prepare for new parking signage for the updated parking ordinance


★ Water Department

- Completed 91 work orders for the month of November
- Approximately 500 feet of water line was replaced on Fifth Avenue from Groesbeck to Cage
- Replaced approximately 450 linear feet of water line on Hyman from Alexander to First
- Water tap set for the Bosque River Trail garden area




